

## SUPPLY LIST

- 1 Pencil, #2
- 1 Eraser, pink or white
- 1 pair of Scissors
- 1 pack of assorted color 9x12 Construction Paper (ex: Pacon Assorted Tru-Ray at [Amazon](#))
- 1 pack of black 9x12 Construction Paper (or 8.5 x 11" size) (ex: Pacon Black Tru-Ray at [Amazon](#))
- 2 Sheets of White Paper (8.5 x 11" computer paper or similar)
- 1 black Fine Point Pen (ex: Sharpie)
- 1 Cup or Bowl of Water for washing brushes
- 1 Toothbrush
- 1/3 cup of All Purpose Flour
- Liquid Tempera Paints (or similar thick paint, ex: Primary Paint Pots at [Michaels](#); Art Minds Washable Tempera Paint at [Michaels](#); Cra-z-Art Kids Paint at [Walmart](#))
  - White
  - Red
  - Yellow
  - Blue
  - Black
- 1 Paint brush - medium size
- 1 Plate, Tray or Bowl to mix paint in
- 1 Paint cup for water
- 1 Toilet Paper Roll
- Glitter Glue (any color store bought, or at home mix 3 tbsp clear liquid glue and 1 tsp glitter)
- 1 small Balloon, blown up
- Paper Towels
- 1 rainbow set of Oil Pastels or Wax Crayons (ex: Crayola Crayons, Crayola Oil Pastels)

### Setting Up Your Space

*Art is creative—and can be messy, too! Here are some tips to set up a space for making art.*

- Wear comfortable clothes that you won't mind getting a bit dirty.
- Use a large table with plenty of space to create and keep art materials close by.
- Protect your tables from paint and spills with cardboard, newspaper, plastic, or some other table covering.
- Have a sink nearby if needed, for easy cleanup and painting projects.
- Ensure you can easily view and access your device when using Zoom. If using a phone or tablet, consider using a device stand. Make sure your device is out of the way of water cups and paints that may spill.
