

SUPPLY LIST

- 1 Pencil, #2
- 1 Eraser, pink or white
- 1 pair of Scissors
- 1 bottle of Liquid White Glue or Glue Stick (ex: Elmer's School Glue, Elmer's Glue-All)
- Liquid Tempera or Acrylic Paints (or similar thick paint, ex: Primary Paint Pots at [Michaels](#); Art Minds Washable Tempera Paint at [Michaels](#); Cra-z-Art Kids Paint at [Walmart](#))
 - Red
 - Yellow
 - Blue
 - Black
 - White
- 2 Paint trays OR paper plates
- 1 small Paint Brush
- 1 Water cup for paint
- 1 pack of assorted color 9x12" Construction Paper (ex: Pacon Tru-Ray at [Amazon](#))
- 5 sheets of Thick White Paper 9x12" or letter size, thick drawing paper, cardstock, or watercolor paper would work (ex: Creatology Mixed Media Pad at [Michaels](#); Pacon Mixed Media Pad at [Amazon](#); Strathmore Paint Pad at [Amazon](#))
- 8.5 x 11" white Copy Paper, 3 sheets
- 1 Black Sharpie
- 1 set of Colored Pencils (ex: Crayola 12 Color Pack at [Target](#), [Walmart](#))
- 1 penny or small coin
- Conte crayons - 4 color pack with red, brown, white, and black (ex. Conte Crayons at [Amazon](#) or [Michaels](#))
- 1 Brown paper grocery bag
- 3 Toothpicks
- Foam Tape for scrapbooking or [Indoor Mounting tape](#) or [removable mounting tape](#).
- 2.5 lbs Air Dry clay OR make at home with:
 - 1 cup of cornstarch
 - 1 cup of white school glue
 - 1 teaspoon lotion (hand lotion, face lotion, whatever is on hand)
 - 1 tablespoon baby oil/mineral oil/vegetable oil (some sort of clear oil)
 - Optional: 1 tablespoon white vinegar or lemon juice as a preservative, to keep the clay fresh for longer if it's not going to be used immediately

Setting Up Your Space

Art is creative—and can be messy, too! Here are some tips to set up a space for making art.

- Wear comfortable clothes that you won't mind getting a bit dirty.
- Use a large table with plenty of space to create and keep art materials close by.
- Protect your tables from paint and spills with cardboard, newspaper, plastic, or some other table covering.
- Have a sink nearby if needed, for easy cleanup and painting projects.
- Ensure you can easily view and access your device when using Zoom. If using a phone or tablet, consider using a device stand. Make sure your device is out of the way of water cups and paints that may spill.
