

SUPPLY LIST

- 1 pack of white Mixed Media Paper (10-12 sheets) (ex: Creatology Mixed Media Pad at [Michaels](#); Pacon Mixed Media Pad at [Amazon](#); Strathmore Paint Pad at [Amazon](#))
- 1 pack of assorted color 9x12" Construction Paper (ex: Pacon Tru-Ray at [Amazon](#))
- 1 Watercolor set with Paint Brush (ex: Prang 8 Color Set + Brush at [Amazon](#))
- 1 pair of Scissors
- 1 set of Colored Markers, 8 colors (ex: Crayola Washable Markers)
- 1 set of Wax Crayons or Oil Pastels, 8 colors (ex: Crayola Crayons, Crayola Oil Pastels)
- 1 Pencil
- 1 Eraser, pink or white
- 1 Glue Stick
- 1 Black Permanent Pen (ex: Sharpie fine point)
- 1 Cup or Bowl of Water to wash brushes

Setting Up Your Space

Art is creative—and can be messy, too! Here are some tips to set up a space for making art.

- Wear comfortable clothes that you won't mind getting a bit dirty.
- Use a large table with plenty of space to create and keep art materials close by.
- Protect your tables from paint and spills with cardboard, newspaper, plastic, or some other table covering.
- Have a sink nearby if needed, for easy cleanup and painting projects.
- Ensure you can easily view and access your device when using Zoom. If using a phone or tablet, consider using a device stand. Make sure your device is out of the way of water cups and paints that may spill.
