

## CLASS SUPPLIES LIST

**CLASS:** Introduction to Acrylic Painting

**INSTRUCTOR:** Cathy Zander

**SUPPLIES:**

- \* Pre-primed canvas or canvas board  
or primed canvas sheets palette,  
or gessoed masonite board,  
or primed paper for acrylic painting.
- \* Acrylic paints, Liquitex, Golden or any other  
(There are two major grades of paint, artist-quality and student-quality. Basically the  
artist-quality has more color pigment and costs more. The choice is yours.)
- \* A selection of 3-6 brushes in different sizes:  
A small "round",  
A medium and /or larger "round",  
A "Flat" about 3/8" to 1/2",  
A "Bright" about 10# or 12#.  
(Acrylic brushes are generally long-handled and somewhat stiff. The quality of acrylic  
brushes is not a critical factor – don't spend lots of money on them.)
- \* A palette or mixing tray  
I prefer a paper palette with tear-away disposable sheets, but a plastic or wood or glass  
palette is fine, or even a piece of cardboard covered with aluminum foil.
- \* A small water container – a paper cup is OK
- \* Paper towels or a rag
- \* Masking tape (optional)
  
- \*\* An idea of what you want to paint from: pictures, photos, still-life items – anything that  
interests you. Or one or more paintings you have already started and with which you want  
help.
